Minutes for March 23rd, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Rose McGinnis. A fabulous corn beef and cabbage dinner was held before the meeting. There were 30 people at the dinner and 34 at the meeting. Trent Minch led the Pledge of Allegiance and President McGinnis asked for a moment of silence. Officers present were President Rose McGinnis, Vice President Elizabeth Taylor, Treasurer Tom Minch, Secretary Trent Minch, Executive Committee Member Arnold Benson and Executive committee member Doug Chamberlain.

Introduction of Visitors and Guests – Jeff Davis of North Brevard Parks and Recreation spoke to the SCA about the Rails to trails property. Currently FDOT owns the property, but North Brevard Parks and Recreation will be responsible for maintaining it. Jeff Davis said that this will be a huge financial undertaking for North Brevard Parks and Rec, since the trail extends all the way to the Volusia County line. He also mentioned that Hurricane Irma has put them behind schedule because of the extensive damage to the shoreline in North Brevard.

SCA Elections - Arnie Benson made a motion that Cheryl Murphy will become the new Vice President of the SCA. Arlene Chamberlain seconded the motion. The motion carried. Arnie Benson made another motion that Tom Minch will be re-elected as Treasurer. Jimmie Sue Benson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Approval of Minutes – Paul Raulerson made a motion that the February minutes were to be approved. Arlene Chamberlain seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Tom Minch reported that our balance this month is \$9590.21. Paul Raulerson moved that the report be accepted and Doug Chamberlain seconded it. The motion carried.

Meeting Hall - President McGinnis reported that attendance at the meeting hall in February was 407.

Public Relations – Doug Chamberlain reported that a sympathy card was sent to Ed Rost in the passing of his sister-in-law Pat.

Membership Committee - Tom Minch reported that we now have 69 members for 2018. Currently we have about 20 to 30 members who still need to renew their membership for 2018.

Mims Report – Ron Barcher reported that on Tuesday April 17th the Mims group will be having county commissioner Rita Pritchard speak to them about current issues affecting North Brevard. All are encouraged and welcome to attend.

NBP&R – Arnie Benson reported that North Brevard Parks and Recreation will be having several Easter activities planned this weekend. He also wanted to encourage SCA members to attend the North Brevard Parks and Rec meetings which are held on the 2nd Thursday of every month at 5pm.

Special Events – President Rose McGinnis reported that she and Cheryl purchased a bingo blower and accessories for \$100. To receive a bingo license, the county requires two members to have background checks. Paul Raulerson made a motion that the SCA spend \$80 to pay for the background checks for President Rose McGinnis and Vice President Cheryl Murphy. Arnie Benson seconded the motion. The motion carried. The first real bingo event will be held on a Friday once we receive the Bingo license.

4th of July – President Rose McGinnis reported that she will help lead this year's 4th of July picnic. The Cebellos family has graciously agreed to cook again. Elizabeth Taylor, Trent and Karrie Minch will manage the water slide and kid's games. Paul Raulerson has lined up the DJ for the picnic. Doug and Arlene Chamberlain will be selling 50/50 tickets.

Old Business – Paul Raulerson made a motion that we spend up to \$200 for new SCA shirts. Doug Funk seconded the motion. The motion carried. President Rose McGinnis plans to order polo, t-shirts, and tank tops in various colors and sizes.

New Business – President Rose McGinnis reported that she will be presenting on May 10th at the North Brevard Parks and recreation meeting. All are welcome to attend and support her as she gives North Brevard parks and rec a glimpse of what the SCA does for our community. Paul Raulerson made a motion that he retracts a previous motion about spending up to \$200 a month for new tables and chairs. Susan Minch seconded the motion. The motion carried. At next month's meeting the SCA will be looking into possible purchasing new carts to keep our current tables and chairs in good condition.

Other Considerations – Susan Minch reported that Bill Posey will be the guest speaker at the Vietnam veterans ceremony this Thursday at 10 am.

50/50 Raffle - The 50/50 raffle was won by Doug Funk. The split was \$20 to Doug and \$19 to the SCA. Doug graciously donated \$12 of his winnings back to the SCA.

Quarterly Raffle – Cheryl Murphy won the \$50 quarterly prize. She also graciously donated her winnings back to the SCA.
